Day of show entries available if maximum of entries are not met by pre-enter deadline. Please keep proof of rabies handy, we will have to validate it. Dogs without proof of vaccination and/or insufficient vaccinations are not allowed on the showground, this includes dogs not entered as well!

6-9 months, 9-12 months, 12-15 months, 15-18 month, Novice, German Bred, Bred By, Open Blue Merle, Open Red Merle, Open Black, Open Red, Winners (all classes divided by sex), Best of Breed, Best of Winners, Best of Opposite Sex, Best in Show

All Current ASCA rules and regulations apply. All Dogs six months of age & up must have individual registration to compete in all ASCA sanctioned events. Jr Handler must enter all required information. All entries must be on the new official ASCA forms with the agreement/disclaimer signed. Incorrect and or missing information will invalidate entries.

ASCA Altered Conformation Program is Open to all purebred ASCA reg. Australian Shepherds over the age of 6 months that are either spayed or neutered. Dogs with LEP numbers are not eligible to compete. Dogs that have been altered may transfer points earned in the regular ASCA conformation program. ASCA Champions of record that have been altered may also compete in BOB competition.

These shows are held indoors on matted floor. There will be a food vendor at these shows, ASCD will offer lunch for a small fee. Set up may begin Friday at 3pm, Sat & Sun at 7:30am, the building will close 30 min after BIS. All exhibitors and club members must be off premises by on Sun evening. You may leave your set ups over night at your own risk, ASCD or Frankenhalle will not be held responsible for any missing or lost items. All dogs must be on leash or confined to a crate at all times except while in the ring during competition. Dogs must be on leash to and from parking area to show ring / grooming/ potty area. Dogs that are on a grooming table must be attended at all times, All dogs must be current on Rabies Vaccinations and proof must be available for inspection by the show committee or facility. Any owners not in compliance with these regulations will be asked to leave the grounds. No refund of any event fees will be given. There are limited electrical outlets and rest rooms on the fairgrounds. There are grassy areas for walking, please be courteous and clean up after your dogs. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by action of the show committee. No entry fee will be refunded if the show cannot be opened or completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God or public emergency. Judges may be substituted. Entry fees will only be refunded if the refund request is received before the pre-entry closing date, no substitutions allowed with dogs that you own or co-own. The Show-giving club, the show chairmen, their agents, officers and/or committee shall assume no responsibility for injury to children.

No electrical and/or mechanical training devices will be permitted on the show grounds. No entry shall be accepted from a dog or handler disqualified from the ASCA conformation program; a dog or handler disqualified from all ASCA programs; or a person not in good standing with ASCD.
